How to Apply

- Must be a high school senior or college freshman for the 2021-2022 school year
- Scholarship must be used for post-secondary education
- Applicants must complete an essay on one of the following topics or a combination:
 1. What money means to me

 3. How I plan to use the money if awarded the scholarship
 4. My favorite money memory
 5. What is the best thing I have learned about money
- Essays must include the following, if missing any information you will not be considered:
 - Cover letter that includes:
 - Name
 - Contact Information (phone, address and email)
 - Current grade level
 - Current/Former High School
 - Post-Secondary establishment attending (if undecided, please note)
 - Page numbers
 - Header on each page with only your initials (for anonymous judging)
 - Double Spaced
 - Size 11 font
 - Times New Roman Font
 - Include 500-1000 words
- Essays must be submitted by July 31st at 5:00pm CST for consideration and can be submitted one of the following ways:
